



Series Championship Points Breakdown

- Drivers must register at a home track to qualify for United Racing Series points. Qualifying tracks are; Delaware, Flamboro, Peterborough and Sunset.
- Drivers must be registered and race at least 60% (rounded up) of their Home Track races to qualify for the United Racing Series Championship. Ie: 60% of 3 races = 2 (1.8), 60% of 4 races = 3 (2.4), 60% of 5 races = 3 (3), 60% of 6 races = 4 (3.6). This does not include special events.
- Points structure for United Racing Series Super Stock events will follow United Racing Series procedures outlined in the general rule book (race points, qualifying points and bonus points).
- A drivers top 5 overall Home Track points earning races from any of the four qualifying tracks will be added to their United Racing Series points prior to the Championship event.

Home Track Event Bonus Breakdown

- Home track bonus points will increase with car count, with two (2) points being awarded to last place and increasing by one (1) point for each position, example a field with 15 cars will pay two points for 15th and 16 points for first. Examples:
